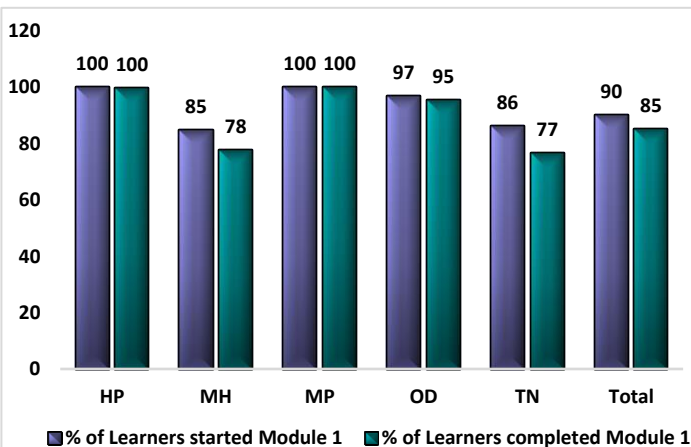
Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of this weekly bulletin on RISE update.

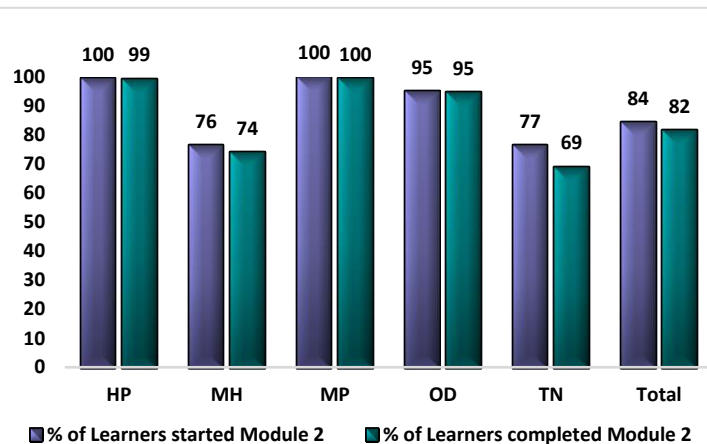

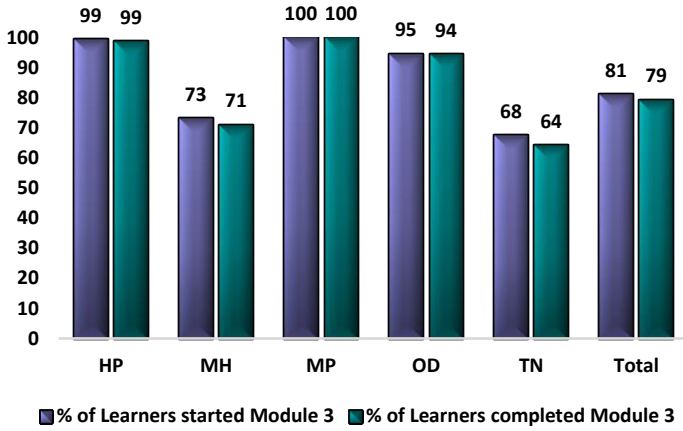

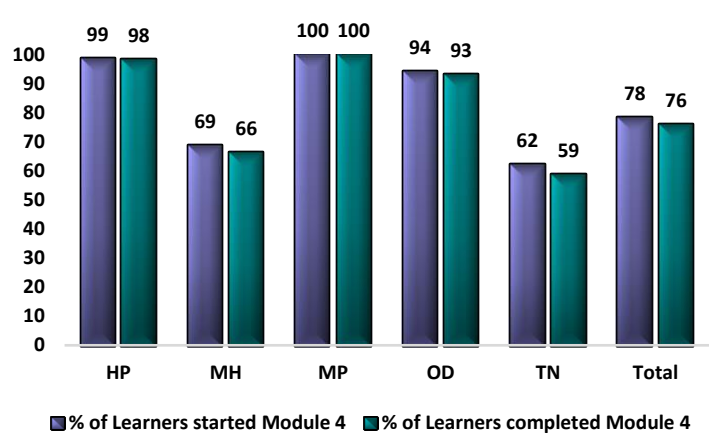


PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – STARTED AND COMPLETED THE COURSE

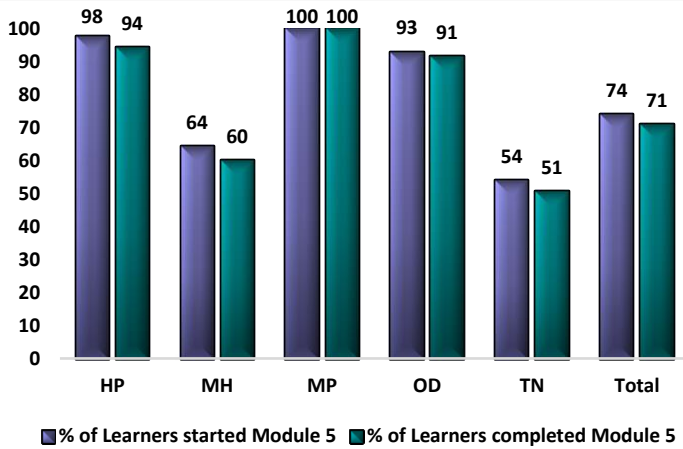

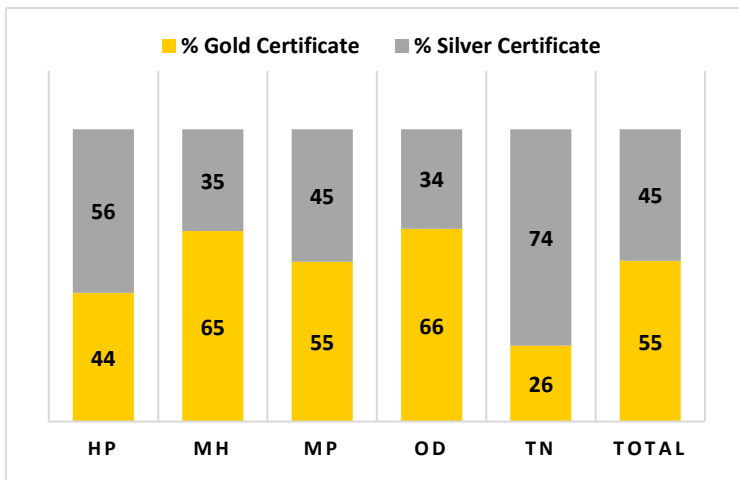

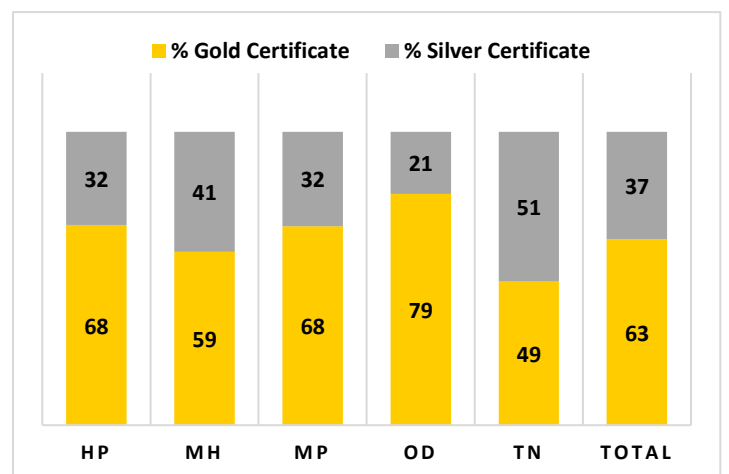
✓ Module 5 has been completed by 78 learners this week, out of which 47 users are from Maharashtra.

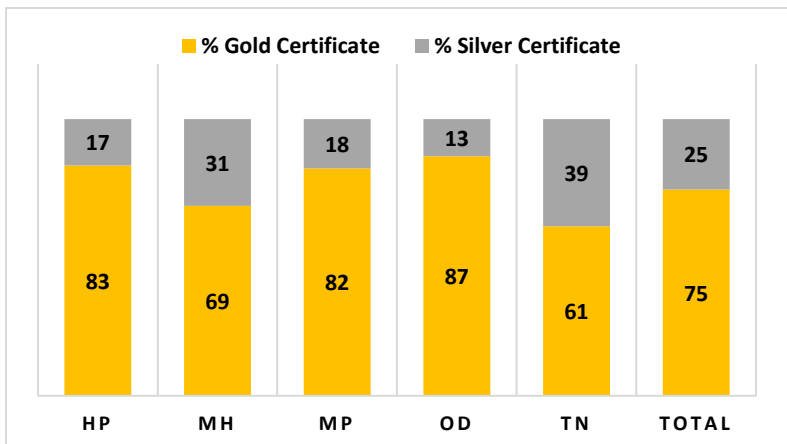

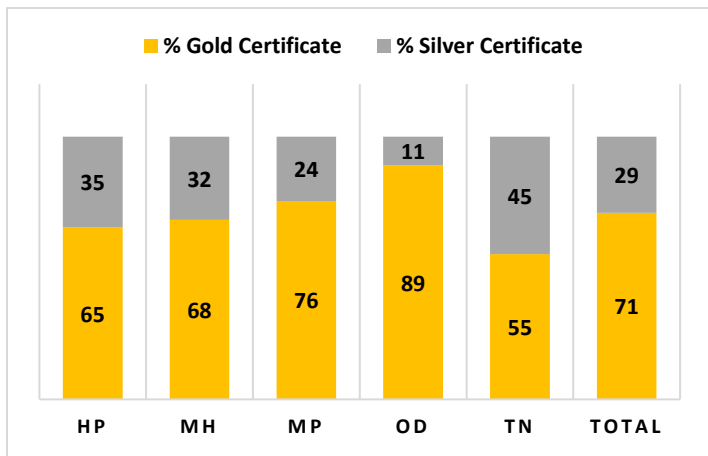


PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS- TYPE OF CERTIFICATE GENERATED

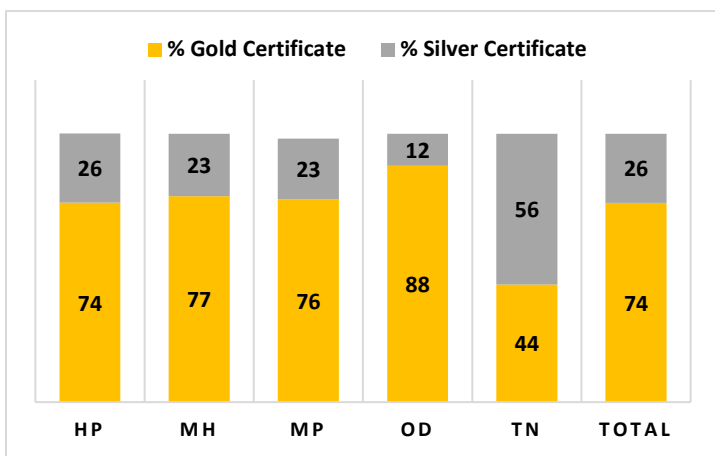

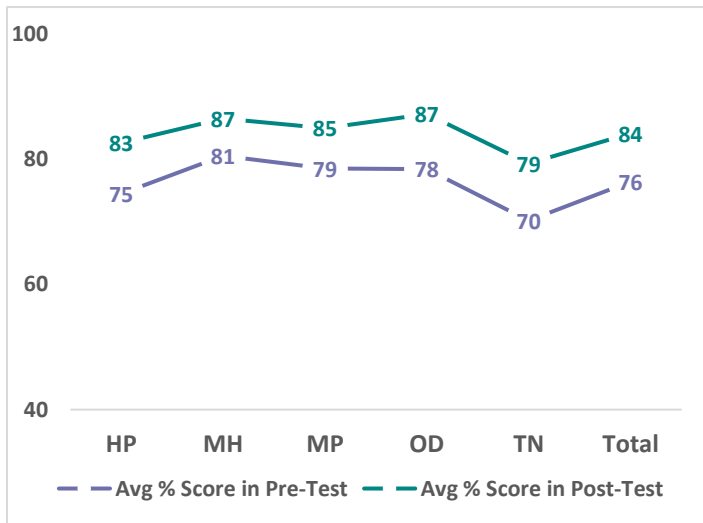

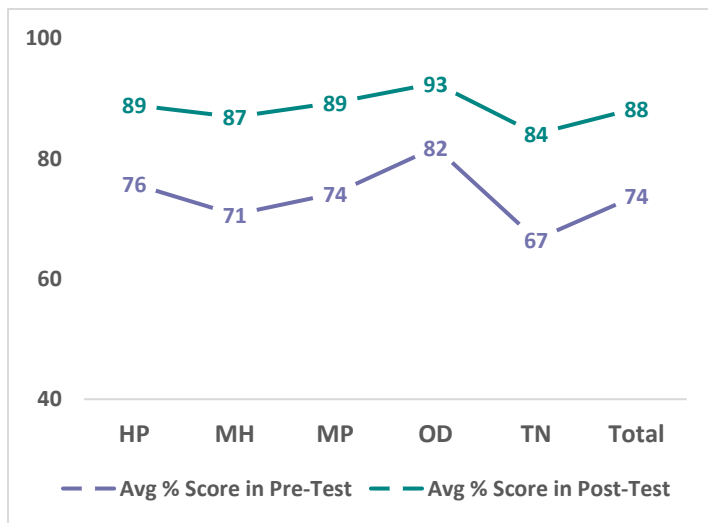


AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES

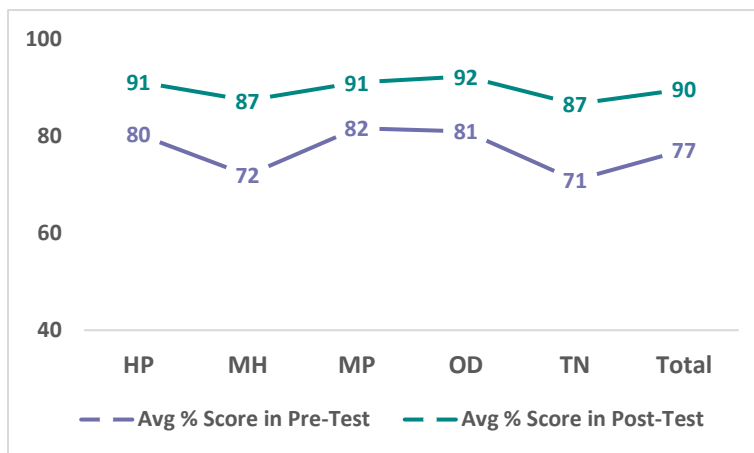

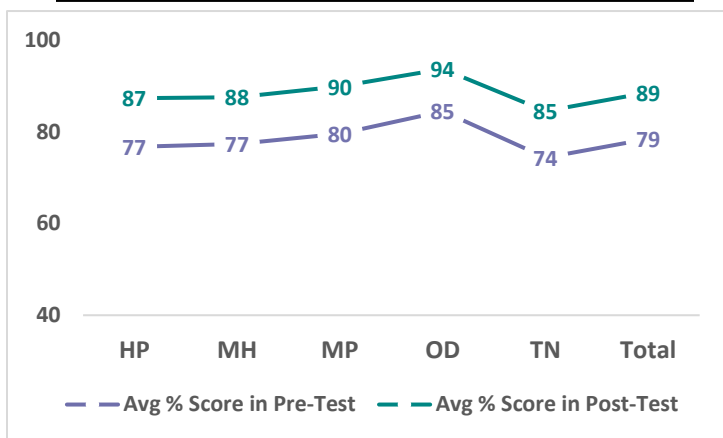


AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES

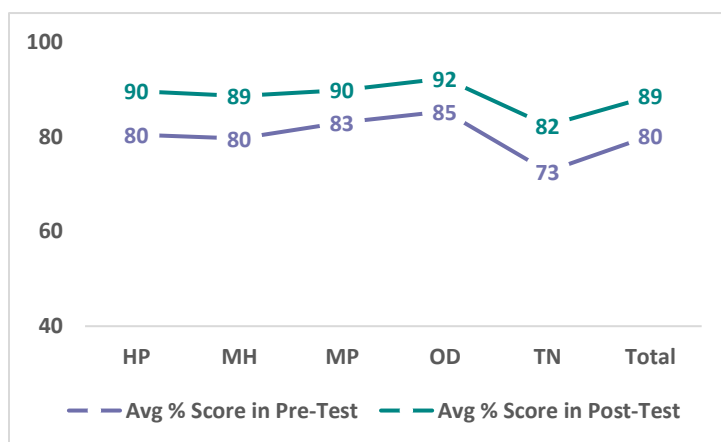

Highlights!!

- Madhya Pradesh has created a history with 100% completion in all the modules within stipulated time
- Himachal Pradesh and Odisha are also quite close to achieve the landmark of 100 % completion.
- Overall, highest knowledge gain (difference between pre-test and post-test scores) has been observed in Module 2 and 3.
- Overall, the knowledge gain is highest in Tamil Nadu.
- Majority of learners have earned gold certificate and the proportion has increased in Module 3,4 ,5
- Highest proportion of gold certificate has been observed in Odisha
- Majority (93-96 %) of learners have completed the assessment in first attempt in different modules
- The average completion time for the module have come down from 9.6 days in Mod 1, to 2.6 days in Mod 5

Mr. Romesh Sirotia, a MPHWS by designation was deputed at DIO Bhopal office in November 2019. As the district was planning to conduct RISE trainings and further implementation, DIO found Mr. Romesh an appropriate person to be the single contact person/nodal person for the RISE programme related activities.

He played a pivotal role since last seven months since the time when we were planning for RISE training in batches. As a result of his dedicated efforts and hard work, Bhopal district became the first among the pilot districts across the country to have 100% completion of all five RISE modules.

He supported RISE implementation in many ways such as creating RISE WhatsApp group of all users and supervisors, resolving queries over the calls, periodic database correction, frequent RISE completion and progress updates, developing peer to peer learning habits by identifying more active users and connecting them with slow starters, and motivating users for competing the RISE course on time.

It requires less time & expenditure to build the capacities and flexibility of doing the course is an added advantage. I am sure RISE will be a game changer in coming time and such training must be developed in other public health programmes as well"**
