Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of this weekly bulletin on RISE update.

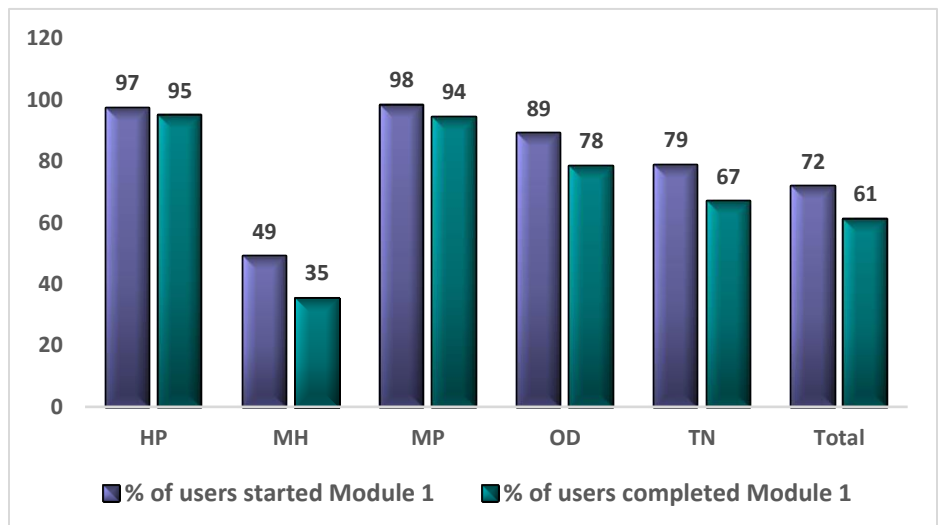

PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS - STARTED AND COMPLETED MODULE 1



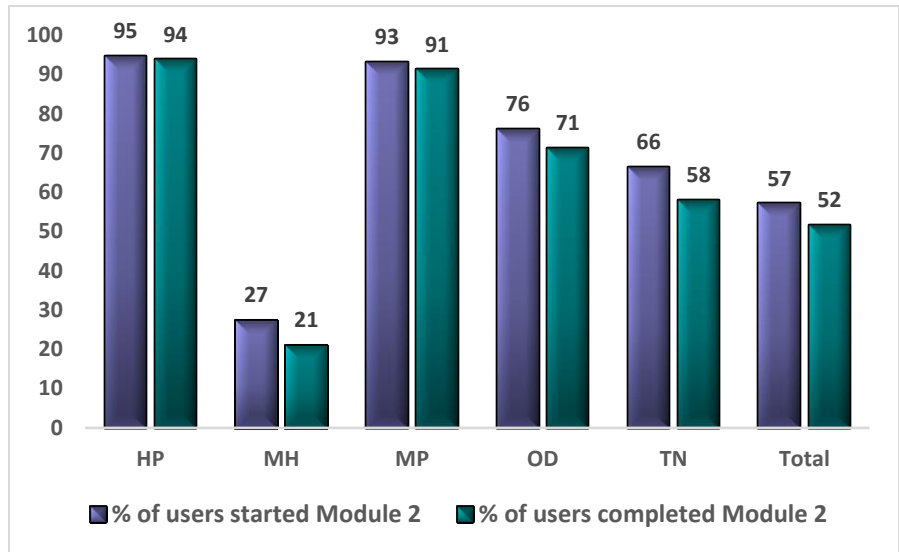
✓ 72 percent of the users have started the training on Module 1 while 61 percent have completed it.

✓ MP, HP & Odisha are leading in the completion of the Module 1, while TNadu and Maharashtra are catching up

✓ Overall, it has crossed halfway marks with 57 percent starting and 52 percent completing it.

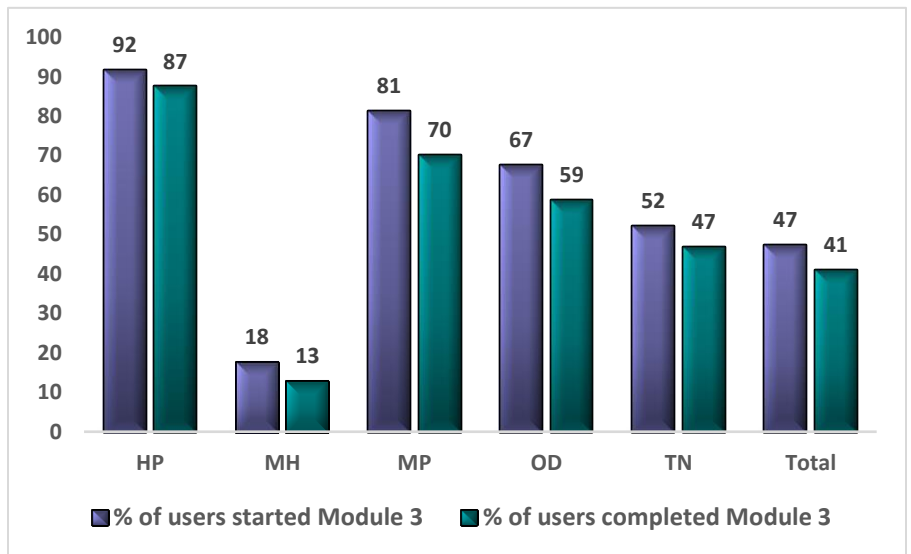
✓ HP and MP are leading in the completion of the Module 2 followed by Odisha and Tamil Nadu.



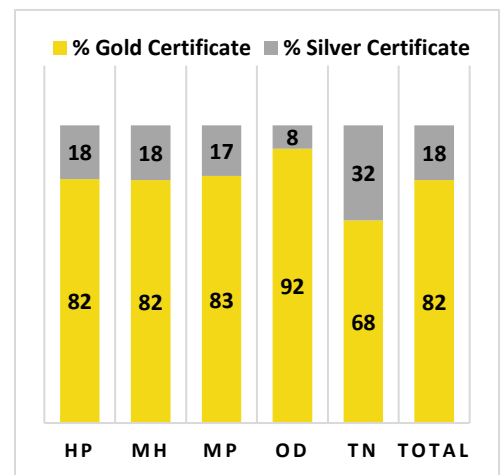
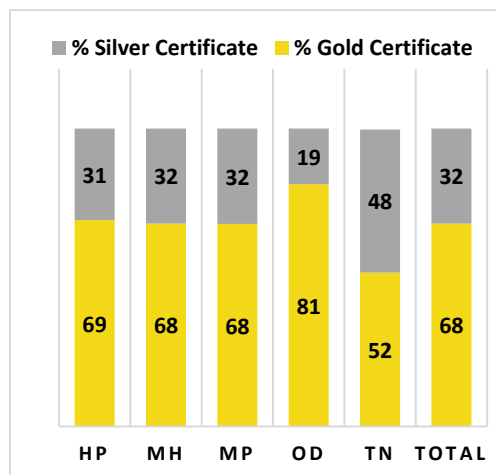
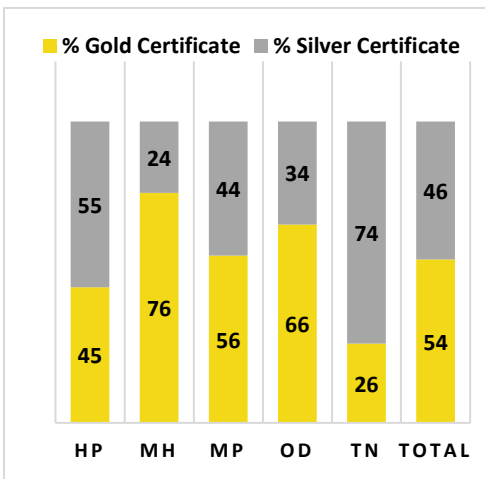
PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – STARTED AND COMPLETED MODULE 3

PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – TYPE OF CERTIFICATE GENERATED

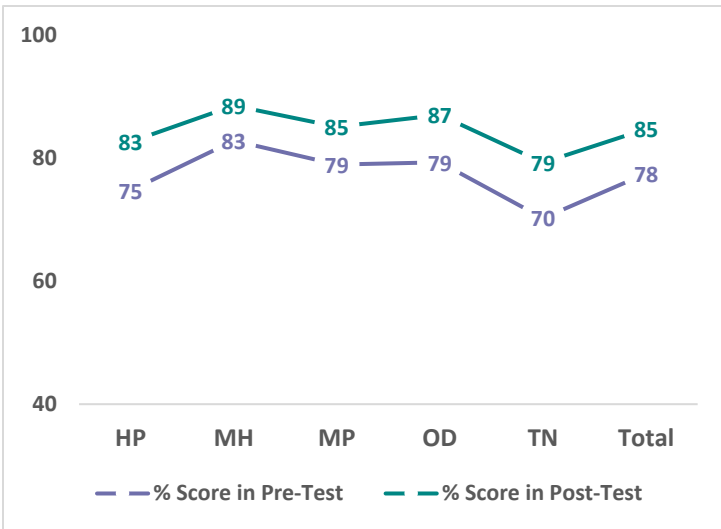

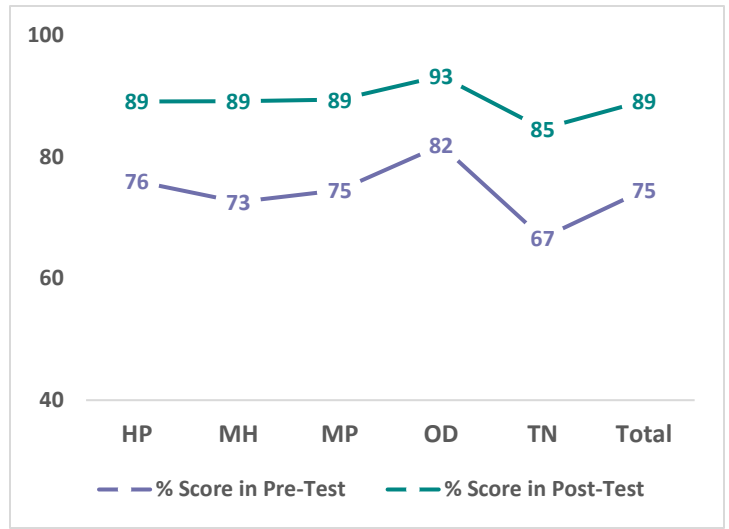

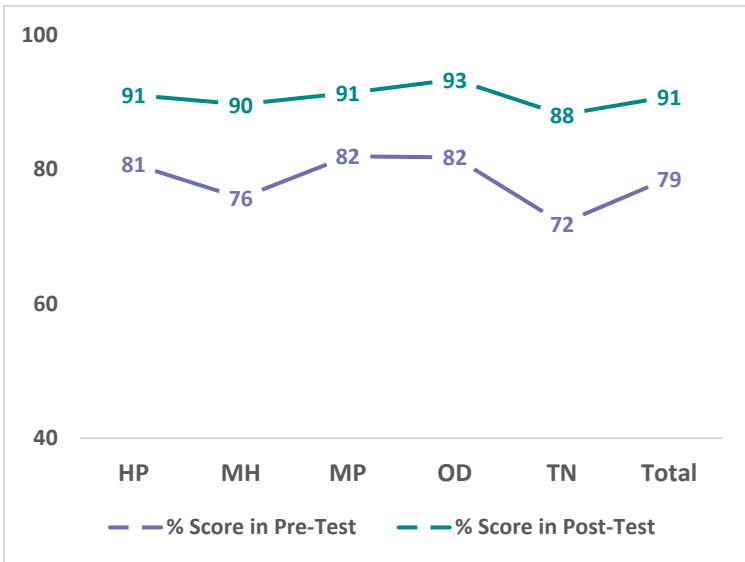
AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES



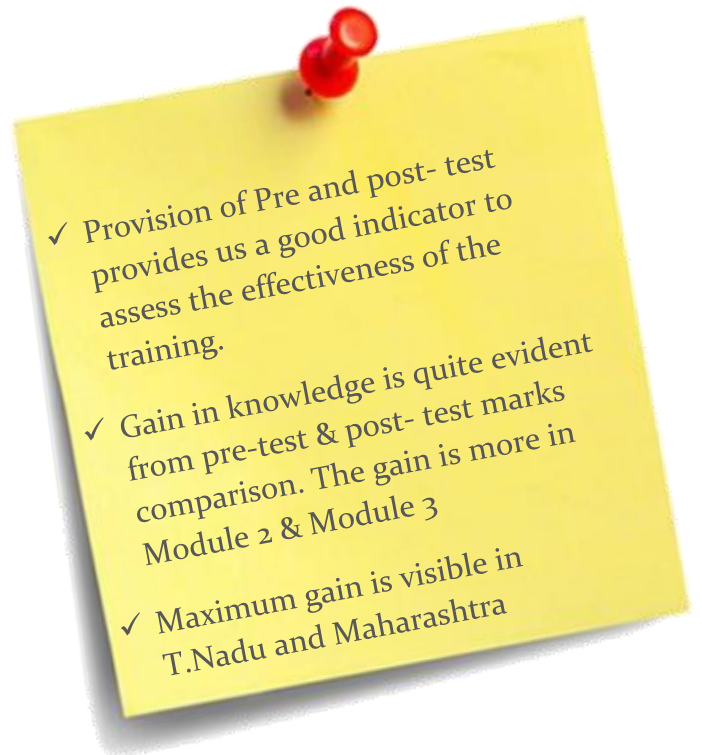
