WEEKLY BULLETIN JULY 10, 2020

Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of this weekly bulletin on RISE update.

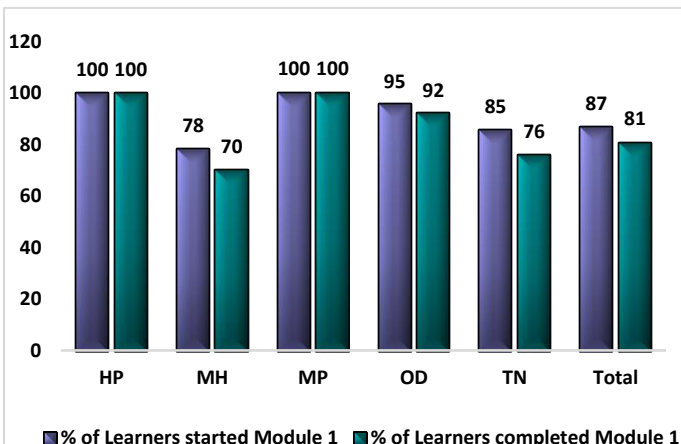

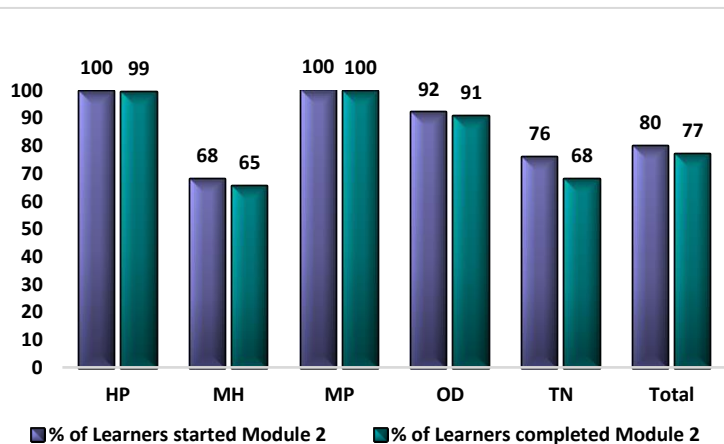

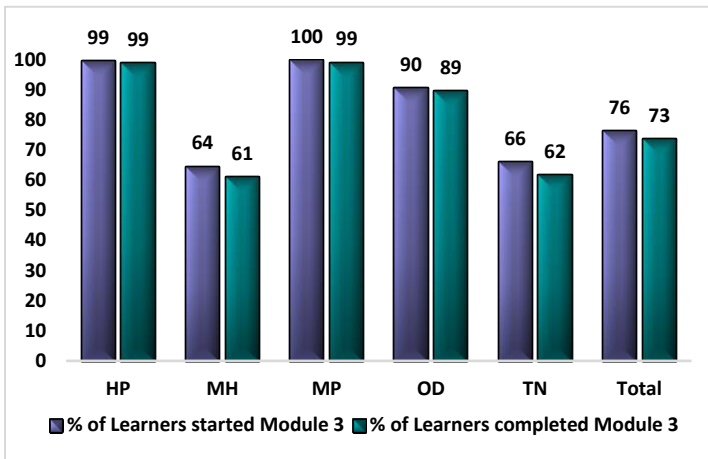

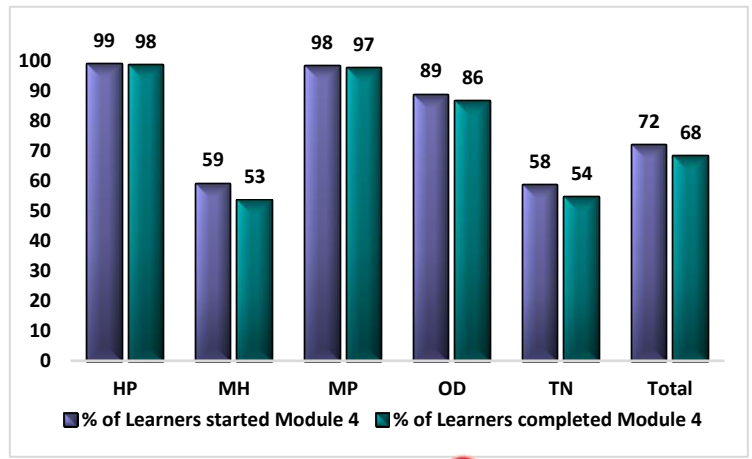


PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – STARTED AND COMPLETED THE COURSE

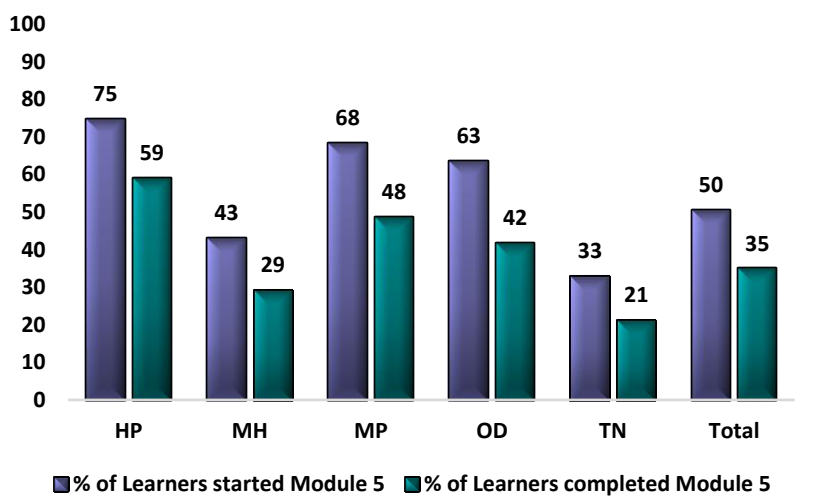

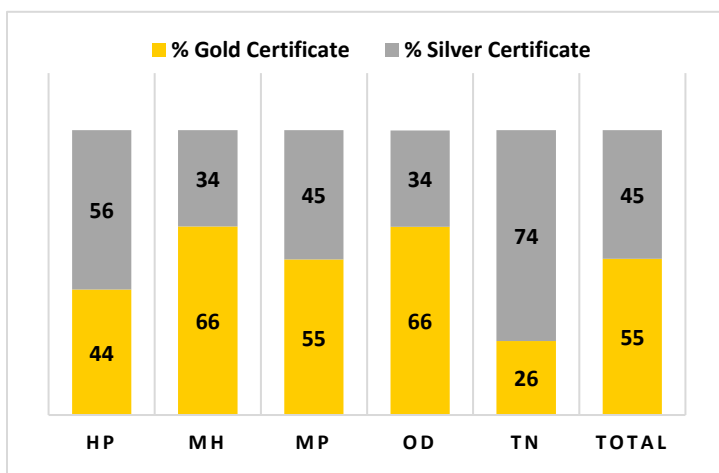

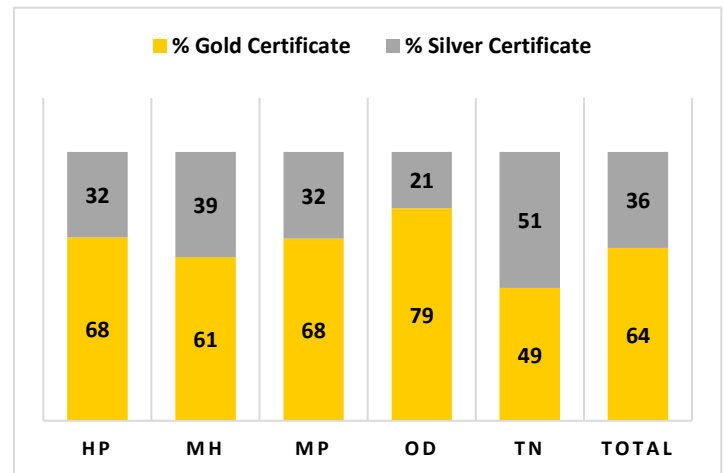
- ✓ Module 1 to 4 completion status is around 100% in HP & MP, while in Odisha, it is around 90%.
- ✓ In TN & Mah a large chunk of urban learners are preoccupied with severe COVID-19 pandemic and thus, the completion is in the range of 55-75%.
- ✓ Excellent start of Module 5 with 50% of learners starting it within 72 hours of Go-live.
- ✓ During the week, more than 100 learners completed Module 4 and 77 learners completed Module 3 too.

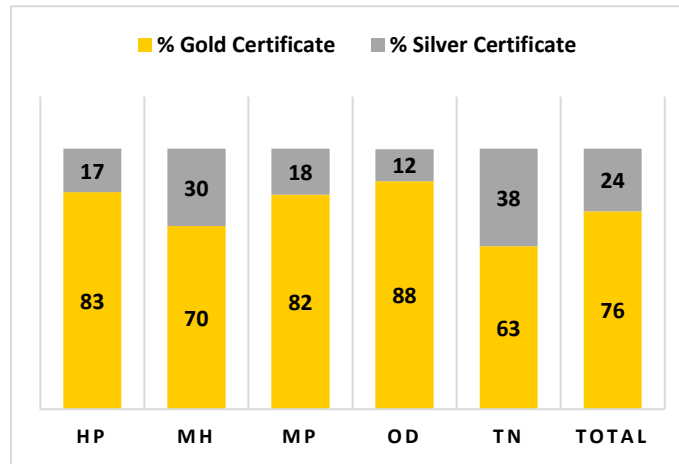

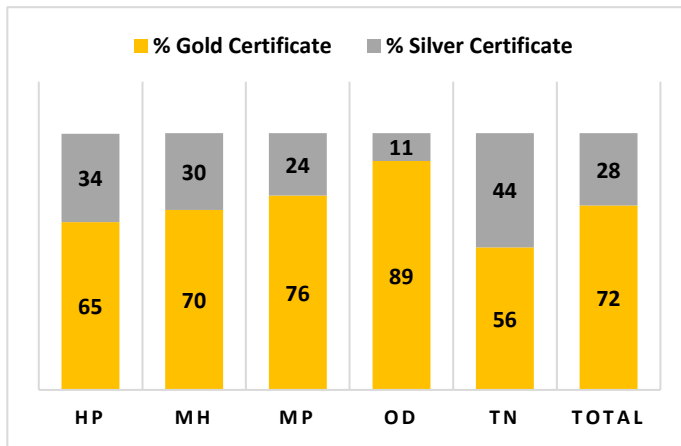


PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS- TYPE OF CERTIFICATE GENERATED

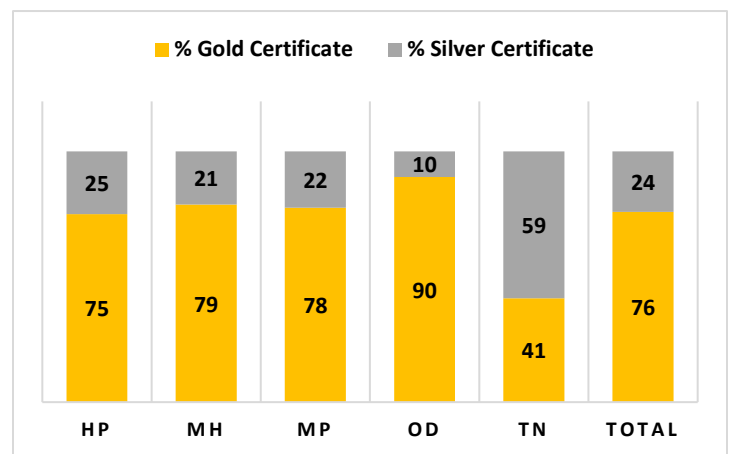

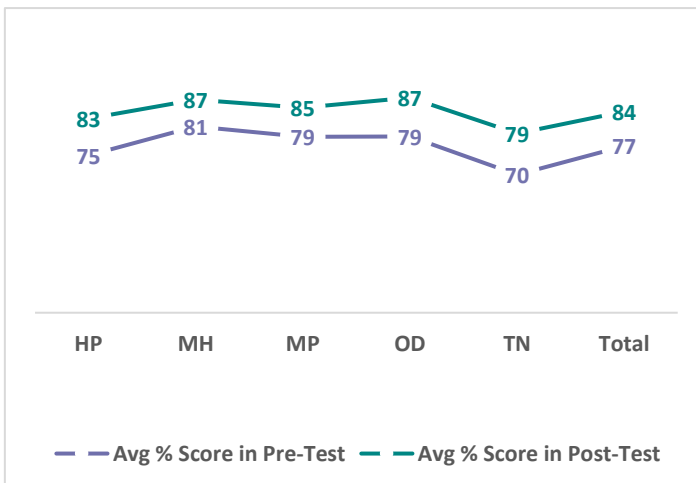

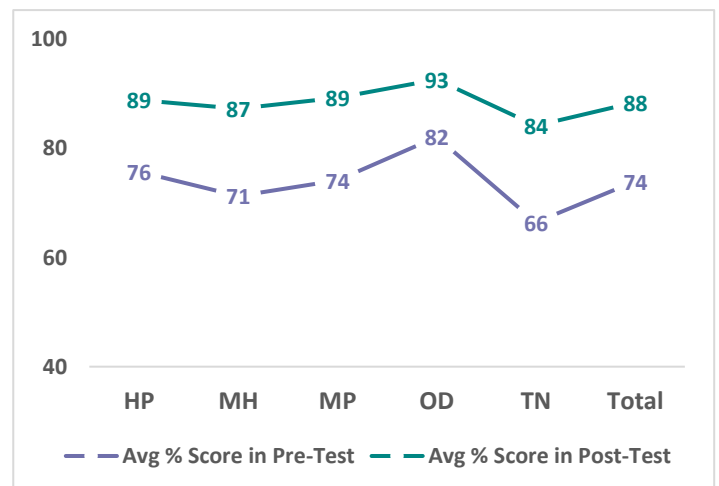


AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES

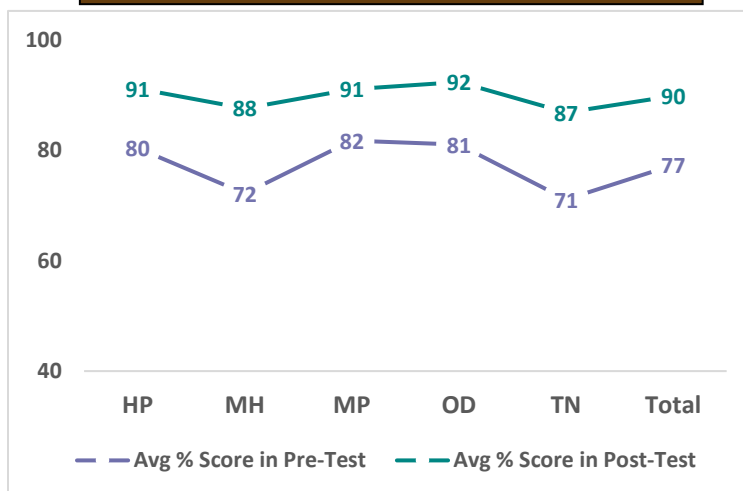

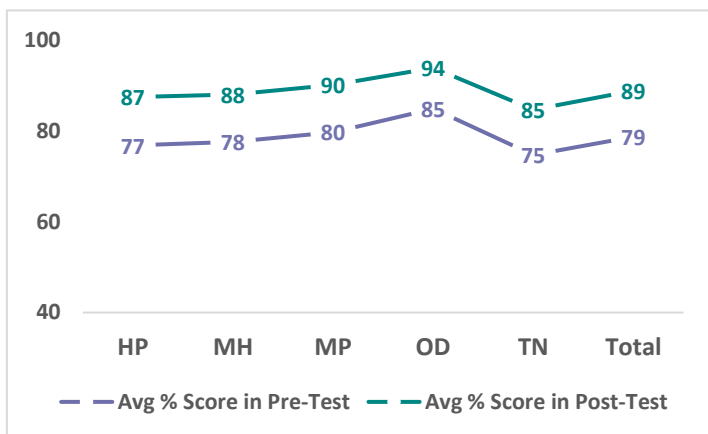


AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES

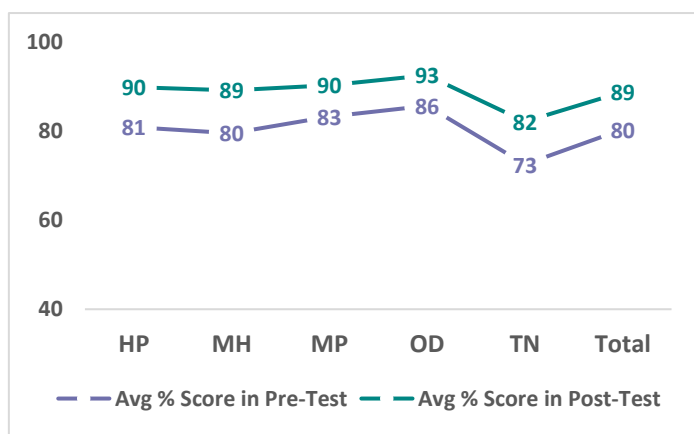

Highlights !!

- Module 5 went live in all five languages successfully on 08 July 2020.
- Maharashtra had a good start in this module. The first learner to complete the module and a large chunk of early completions on the first day were from Maharashtra.
- Odisha has the highest proportion of gold certification across the modules.
- Mod 3 & 5 show the highest proportion of gold certificates among the modules
- Higher knowledge gain (gap between Pre and Post test score) is observed in Module 2 & 3

Nagalakshmi, 53 years old veteran VHN of 30 years of service received the training of RISE in the month of February 2020 at the Egmore training centre.

She said she was waiting for the Module 5 roll-out and the moment she found it live, though it was the wee hours of the day, she started and completed it within two hours.
