Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of this weekly bulletin on RISE update.

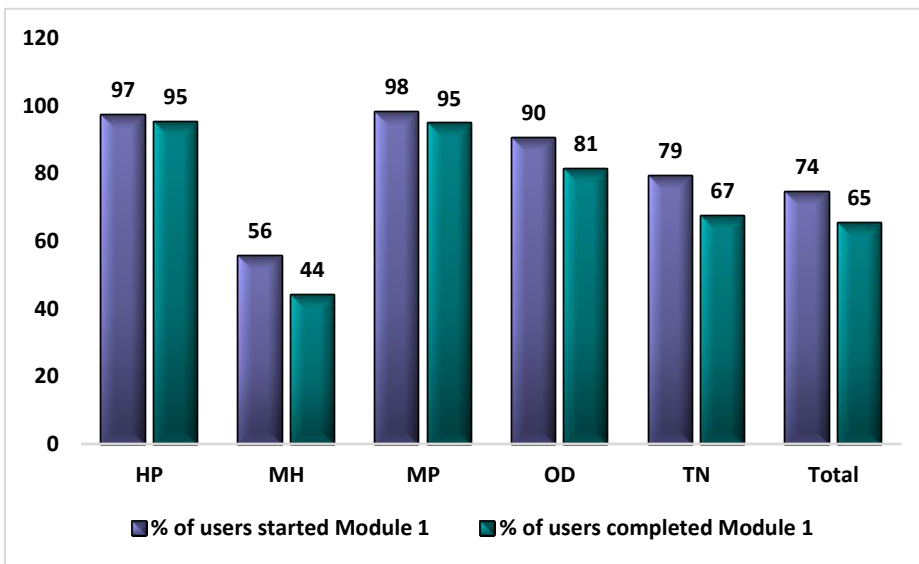

✓ 74 percent of the users have started the training on Module 1 while 65 percent have completed it.

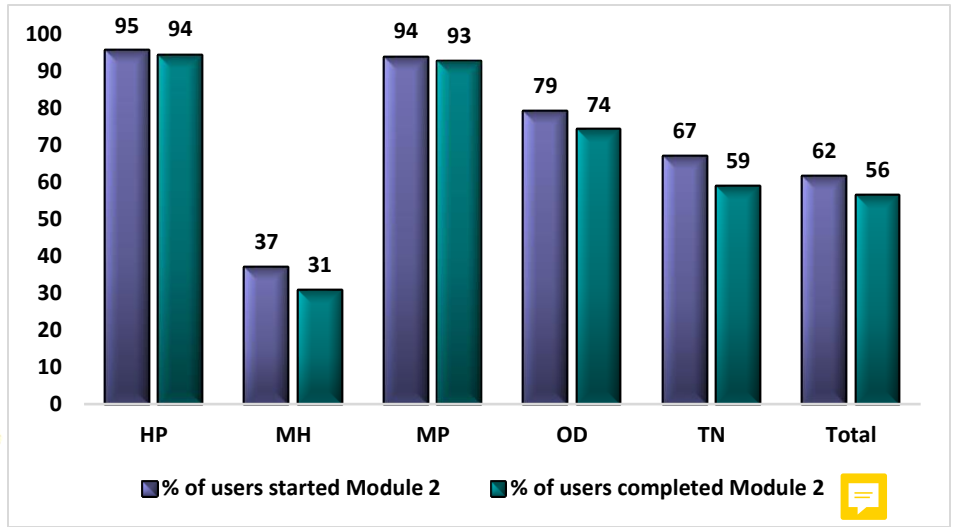
✓ MP & HP are leading while Odisha & T.Nadu are also doing well. Maharashtra is catching up

✓ Overall, it has crossed halfway marks with 62 percent starting and 56 percent completing it.

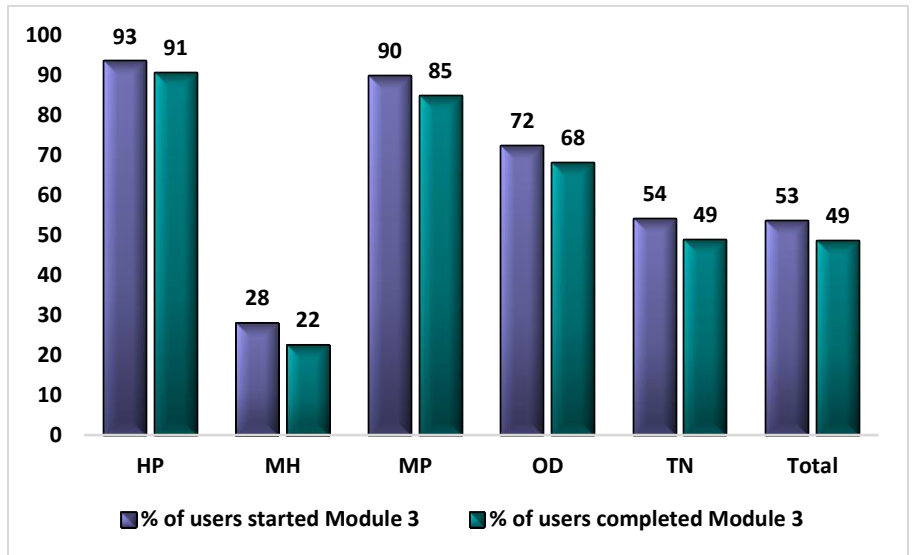
✓ HP and MP are leading in the completion of the Module 2 followed by Odisha and Tamil Nadu.



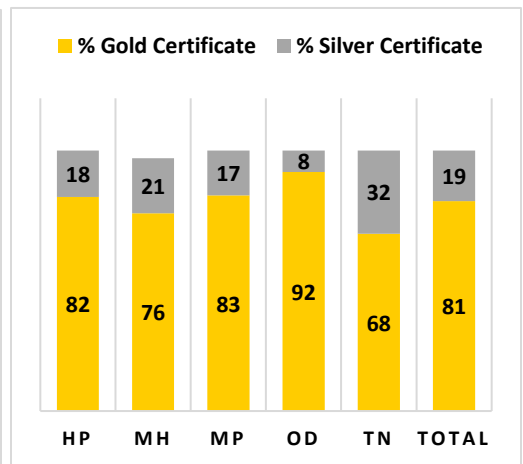
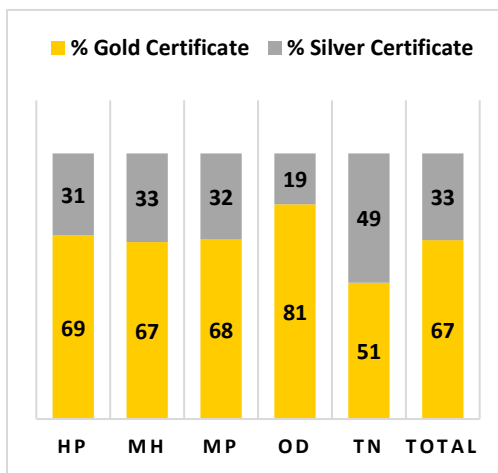
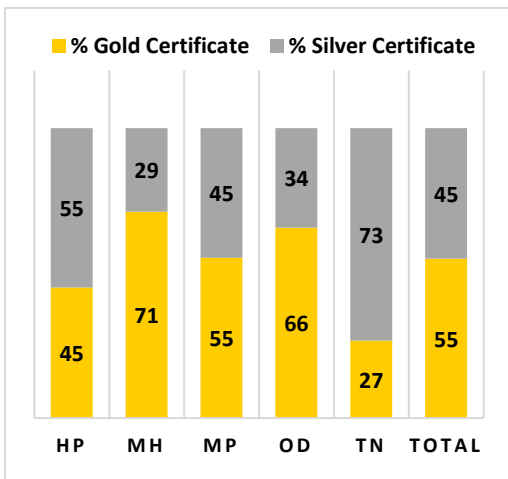
## PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – STARTED AND COMPLETED MODULE 3

## PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – TYPE OF CERTIFICATE GENERATED

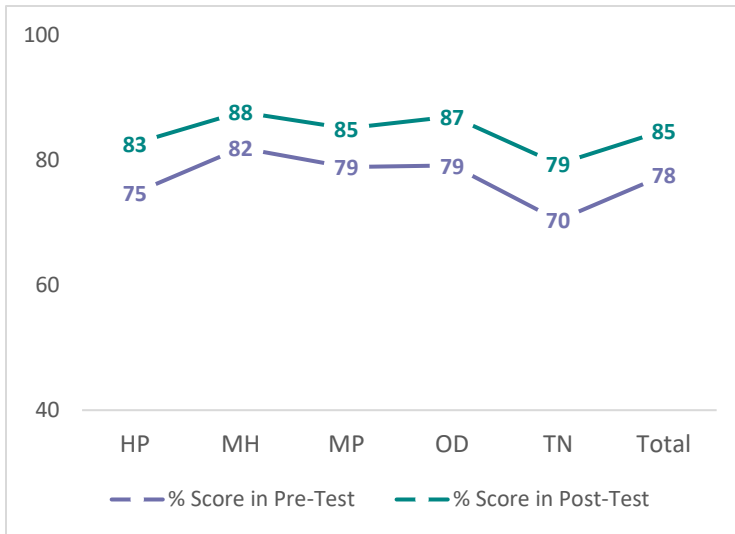

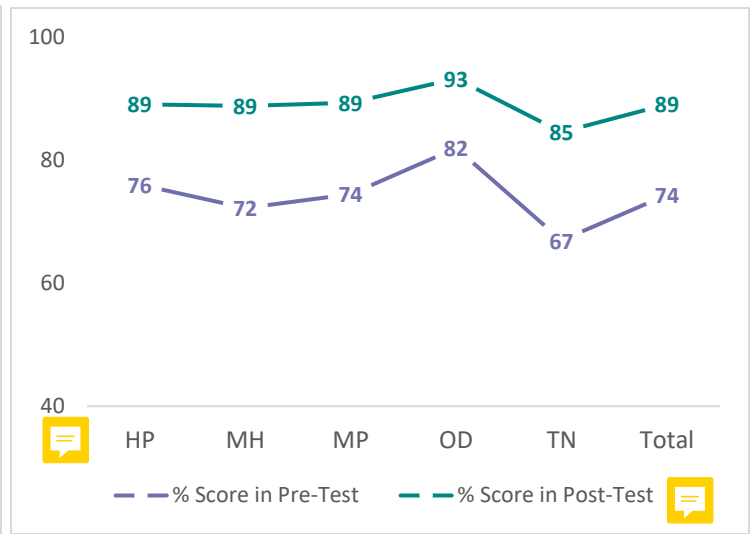

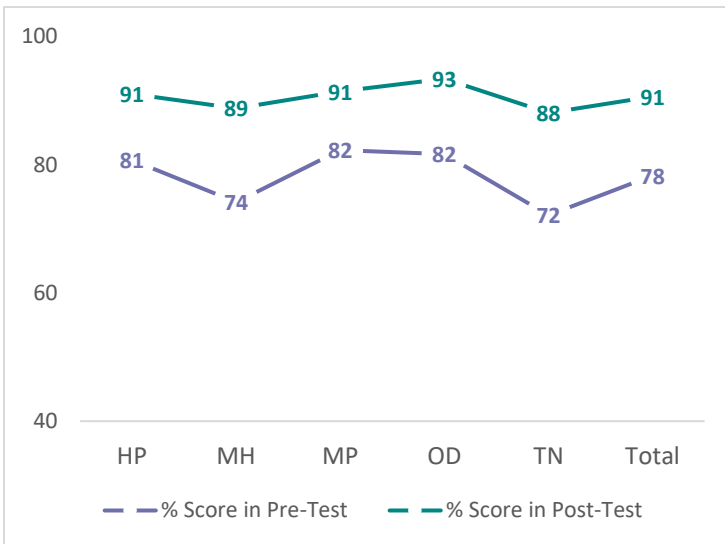
# AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES



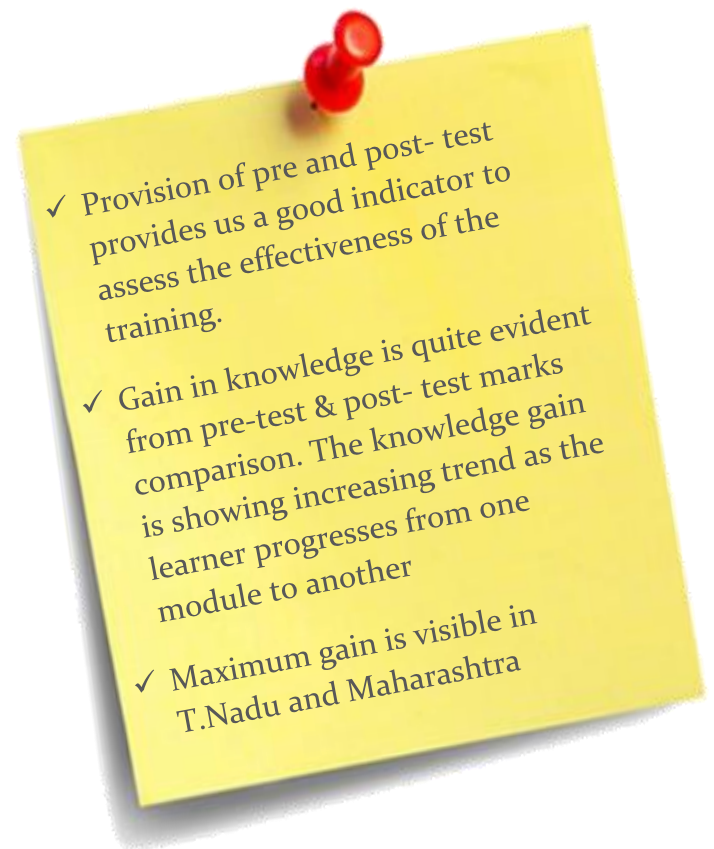
