WEEKLY BULLETIN JULY 17, 2020

Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of this weekly bulletin on RISE update.

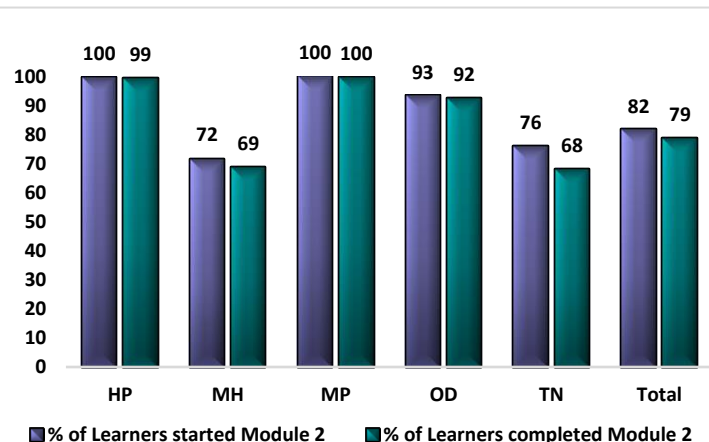

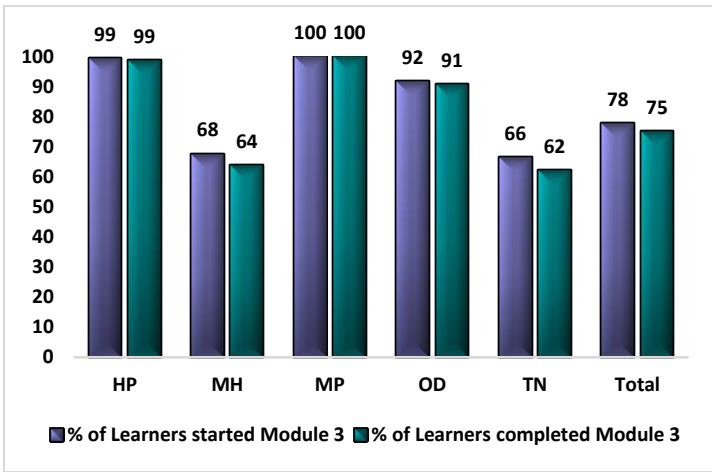

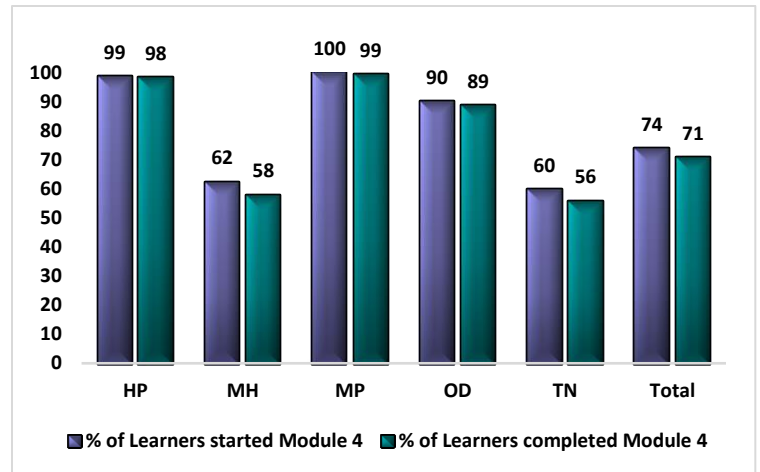


PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS – STARTED AND COMPLETED THE COURSE

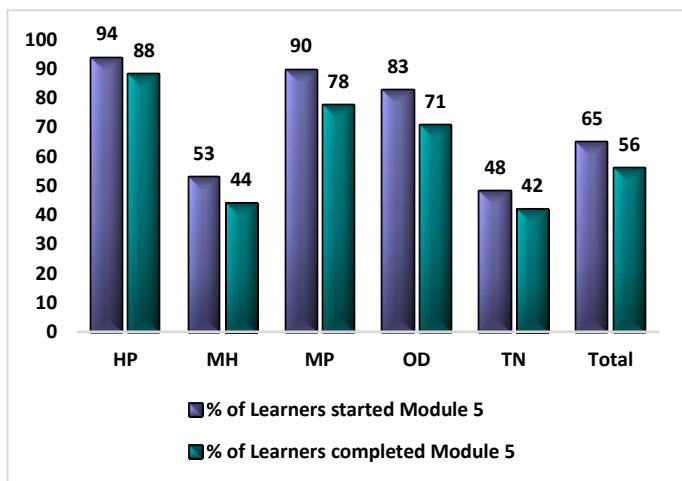

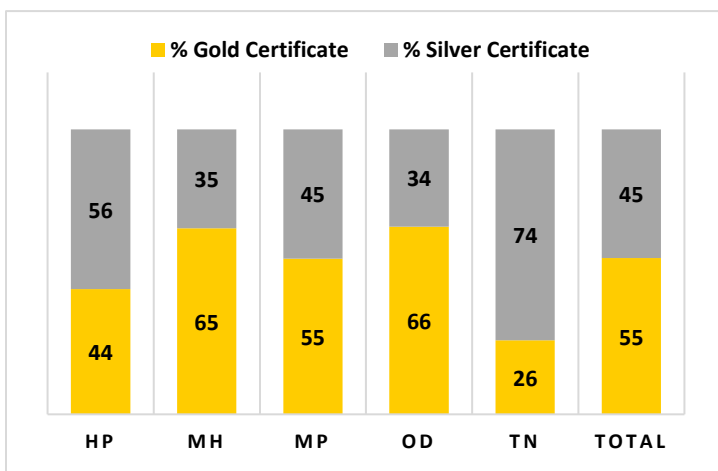
✓ Excellent progress in Module 1,2,3 & 4 in Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha.

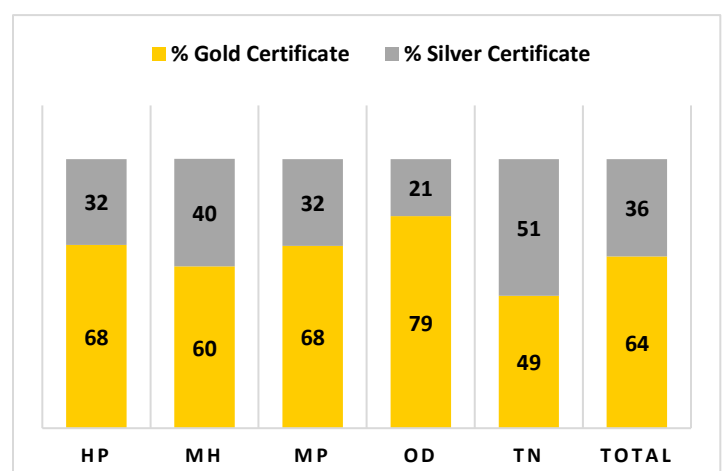

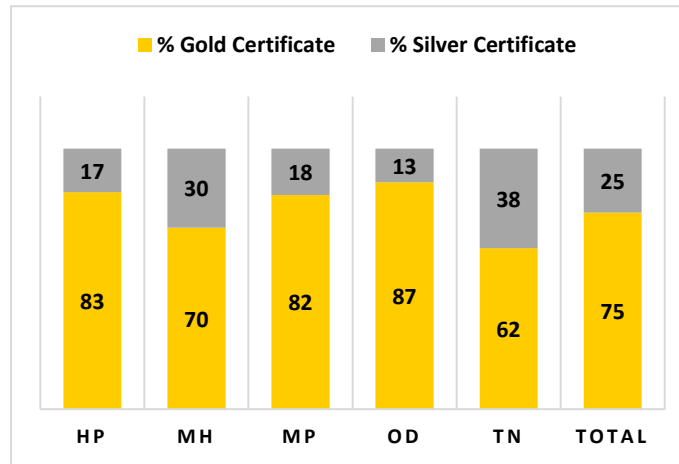

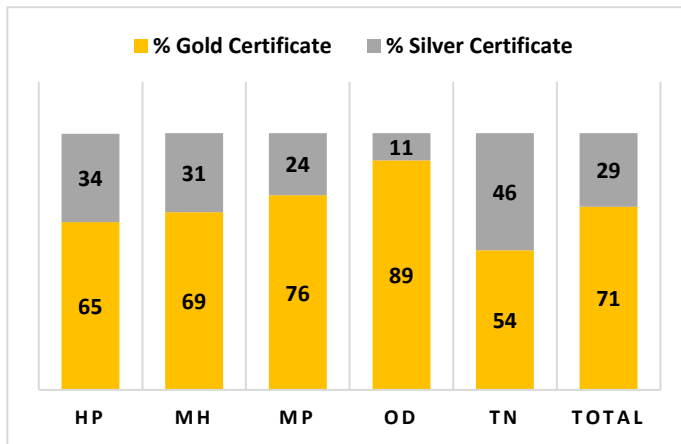


PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS- TYPE OF CERTIFICATE GENERATED

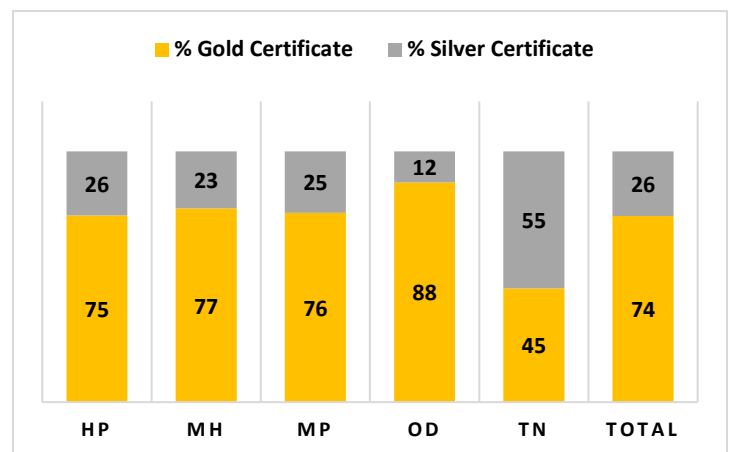

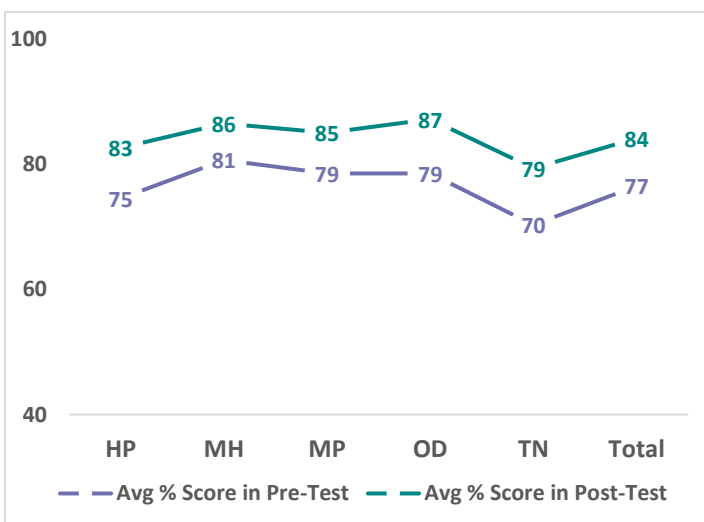

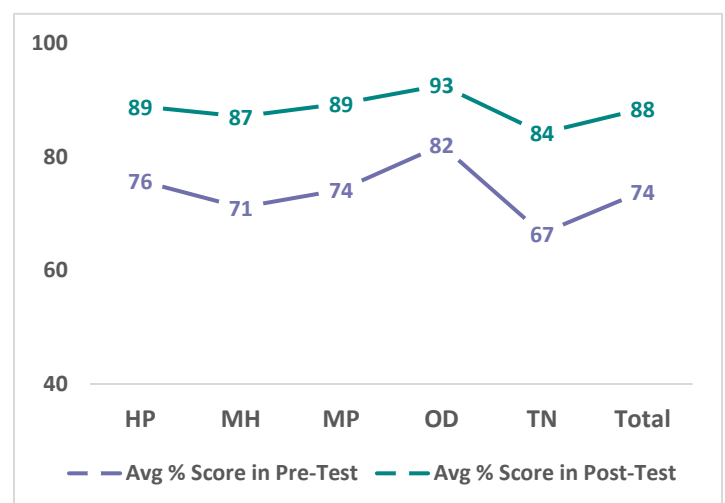


AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES

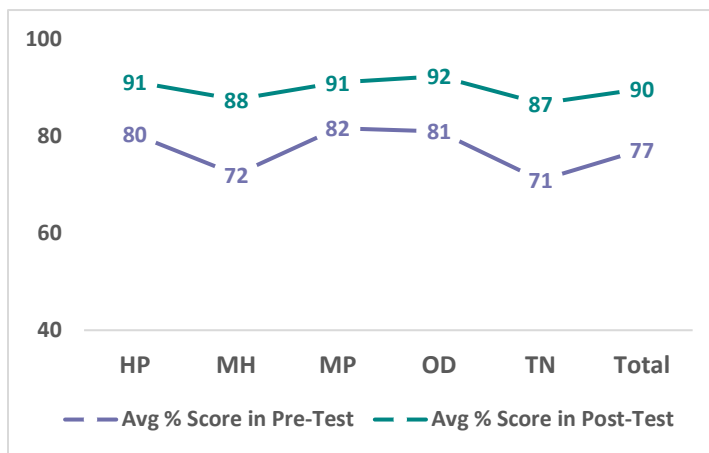

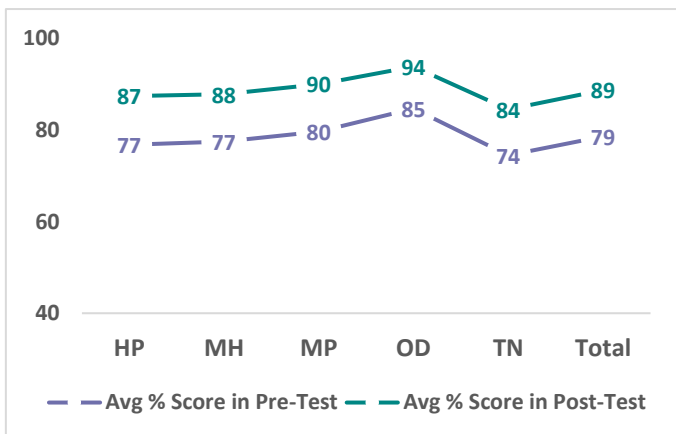


AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF PRE AND POST TEST SCORES

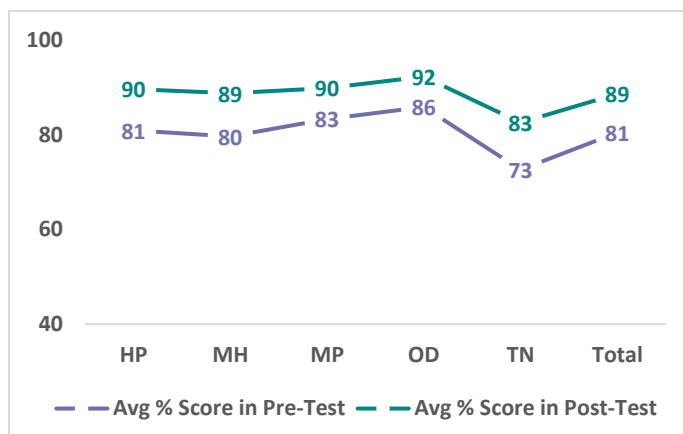

Highlights !!

- In Madhya Pradesh, 100 % of learners have started first four modules (1,2,3 & 4). Likewise, the completion is also 100 per cent in Module 1, 2 and 3.
- In Himachal Pradesh, 100% learners have started M1 & M2 while 99% have started M3 & M4.
- Himachal is also leading in M5 with 88% learners having completed it within first 10 days of go live
- Maharashtra is steadily catching up with more than 60% learners starting all the first four modules
- Trend of Gold certificate remains consistently high in Odisha in all modules, especially in Module 4.
- Overall, good knowledge gain (Pre and Post score gap) is observed in Module 2, 3 and 4. Tamil Nadu has shown the highest knowledge gain in almost all modules

RISE dashboard gives confidence to supervisors

“At the very onset of RISE program, I had many apprehensions regarding the course. When I took charge as MO I/C, apprehensions changed to challenges. With poor mobile network and difficult terrain, convincing the staffs was a great challenge. But to my surprise, the **enthusiasm shown by my staffs to participate in this programme was heartening**. Even during the time of COVID, we have successfully completed all the modules of the training within the stipulated time. It was possible by delegating the responsibility of supervision to sector supervisors who closely supervised 5-6 vaccinators each by keeping in regular touch with them and encouraging them. **Thanks to NHM team, especially to Mr. Alok Dash, the BDM, for arranging internet connectivity at sector level and encouraging the staffs to use this for completion of RISE training**. Such type of training is the need of the hour and I really appreciate the team RISE for such a marvelous idea and training package. RISE has carved its niche in the capacity building programmes. The benefit of RISE is visible when you meet a health staff at an immunization session. She is observed to be clear in her thoughts and composed and confident. **By giving real time data on various aspects of progress, supervisor dashboard gives confidence to the supervisor. Tracking of health staffs at a large scale is at the fingertips.**”
