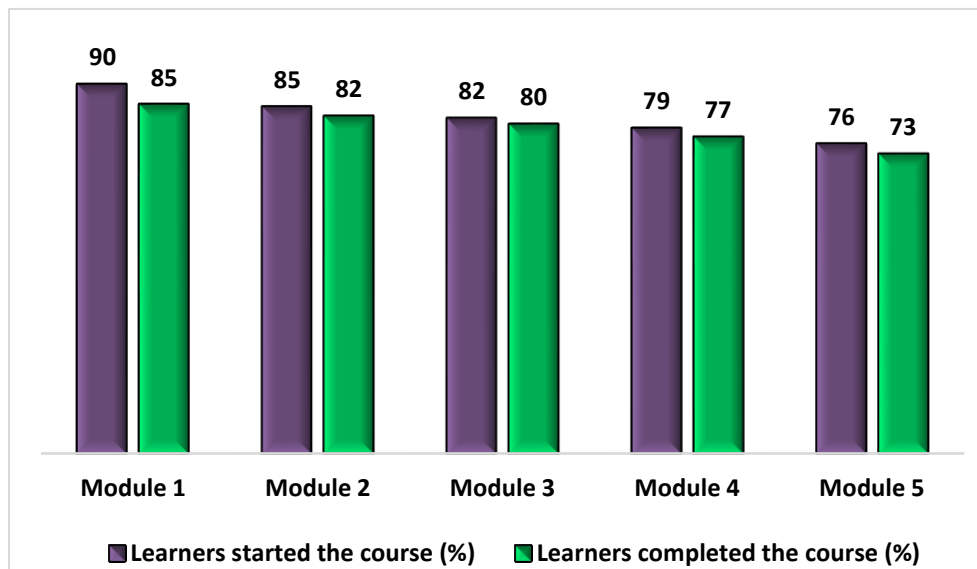

Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of this weekly bulletin on RISE update.

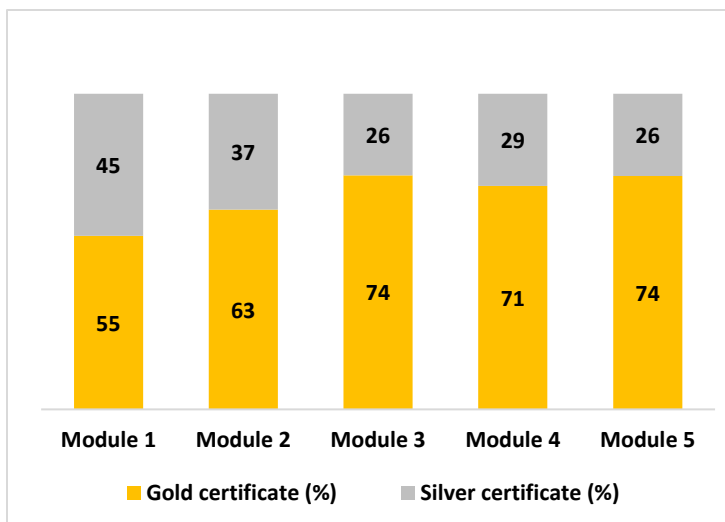

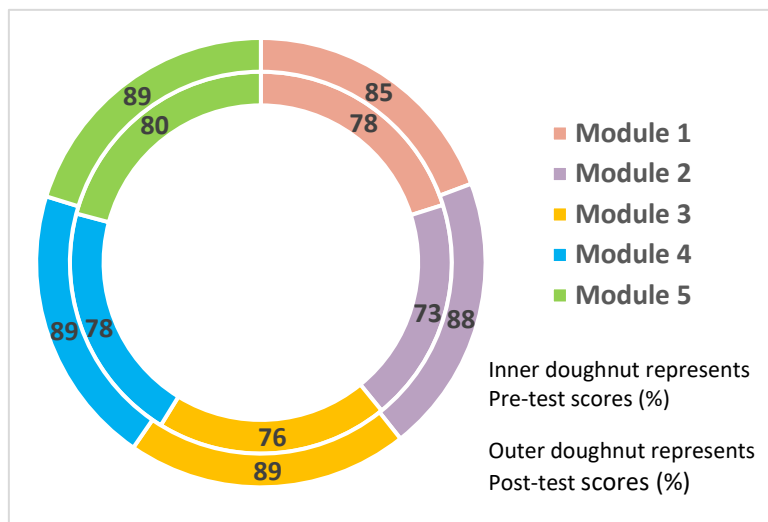
PERCENTAGE OF LEARNERS (all 5 states) – STARTED AND COMPLETED THE COURSE

Highlights!!

- Last fortnight, the Blocks of Tikar, Matiana, Rampur and Shimla urban, in Himachal Pradesh have achieved 100% completion in all the modules.
- As a state, Madhya Pradesh had already achieved 100% completion in all 5 modules and now Himachal Pradesh has also achieved 100% completion in all modules, except Module 5
- Average knowledge gain of all five modules is 11 points (77 % in Pre-test and 88 % in Post-test).
- As an average, 67 % of learners received gold certificate in all the modules while silver certificate is grabbed by 33 per cent of the learners.
- Majority (95%) of learners have completed the post- assessment in first attempt.
- The average completion time for the module was 10 days in Module 1 and shown a reducing trend over the subsequent modules.
