Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of the bulletin on RISE updates.

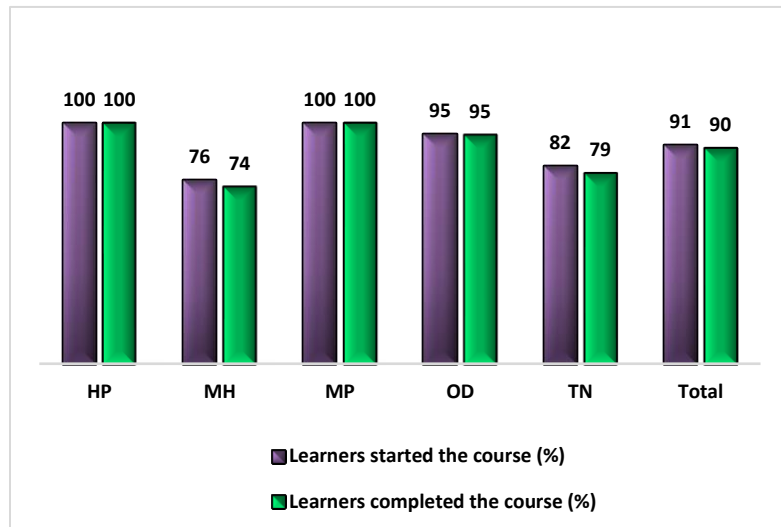
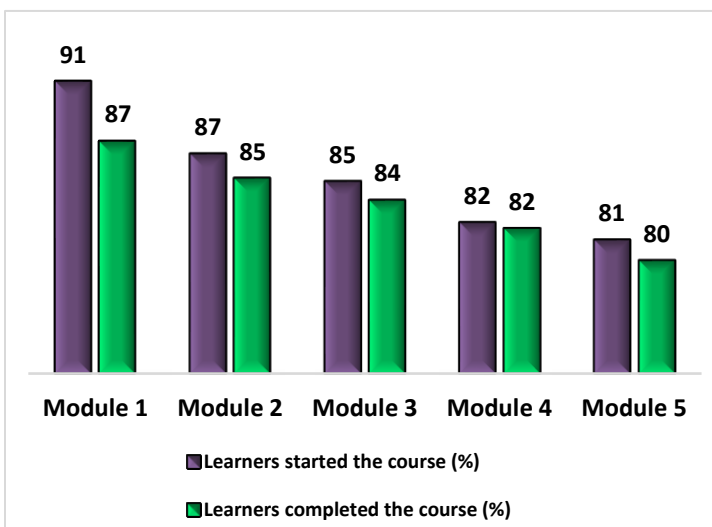

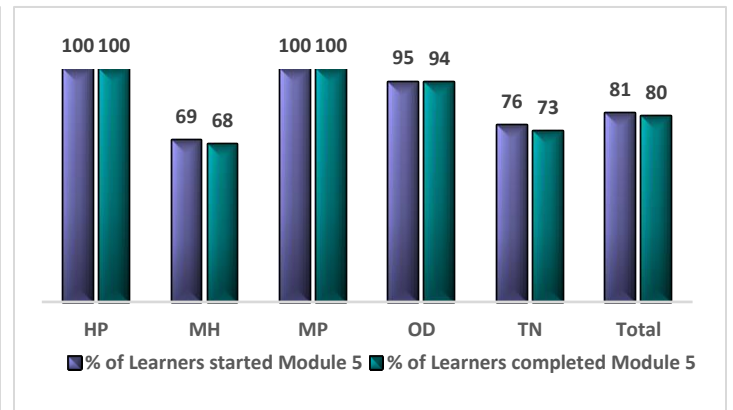
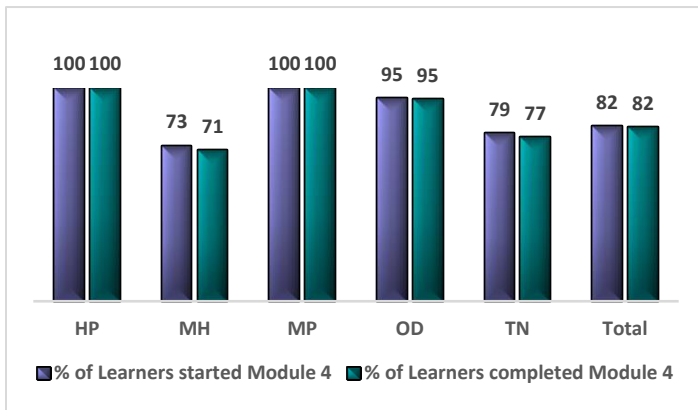

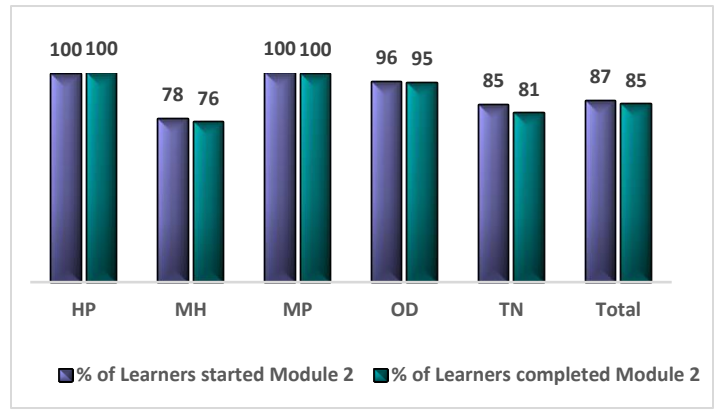
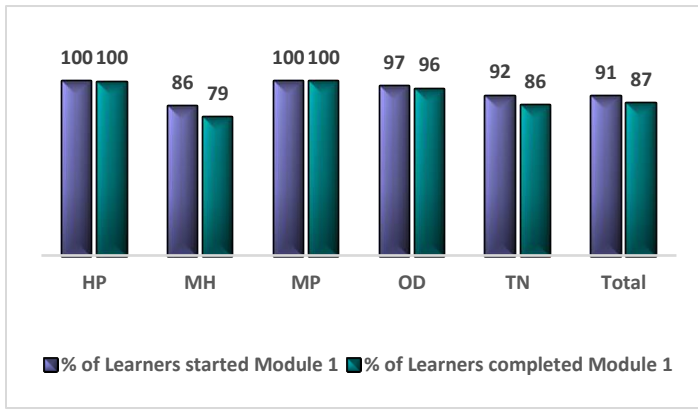

COVERAGE (average of 5 states)- Module-wise

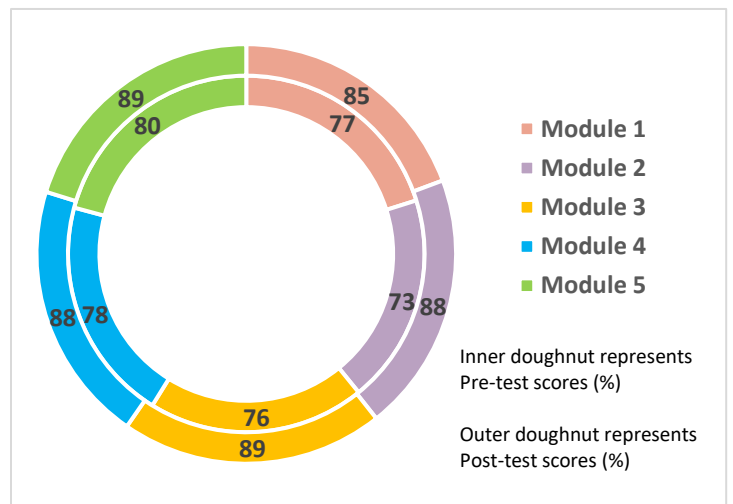
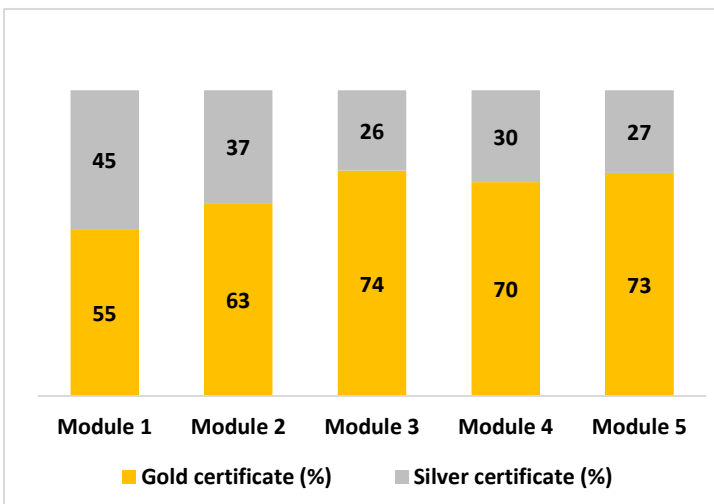
COVERAGE (average of 5 modules)- State-wise

"RISE- useful Application for VHNs

RISE program was started in the month of March in our state. Since its launch, RISE has been **a very convenient and useful app for VHNs** because it has polished their knowledge and skills of immunization in the field such as site of vaccine administration and dose of vaccination, practice of using hub-cutter, bio-medical waste segregation and so on. In addition, immediate doubt resolve is a great advantage of the application and it helps to settle down the patient's queries as quickly and clearly.

They had completed the modules at their own pace and more than 20 percent of them earned gold certificate. The improvement in post-test scores also indicates that the **application has been extremely helpful and friendly for VHNs**.

I suggest to extend the application to MCH, IMR, NNMR and so on. **Such trainings will be helpful to all cadres of the health workforce.**
