Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a complementary capacity building package to strengthen the ongoing training of frontline health workers engaged in routine immunization under Universal Immunization Program of Government of India. This user-centric model optimally leverages the high technology (mobile phone, internet) penetration among the health workforce and effectively uses a digital training content supported by a face-to-face component of mentoring by supervisors. The digital part is primarily self-learning through an objective focused content based on adult learning principles that engages the learners through a variety of audio, animated visuals, reading and interactions like learning games and quizzes. It also has a provision of objectively assessing the learning and certification to make it more attractive to the learners. An open-source Learning Management System (LMS) has been custom made to manage and deliver this digital content and provide a real-time monitoring dashboard which enables problem-solving and mentoring by supervisors. The dashboard is the basis of the bulletin on RISE updates.

Mr Gopendra Kulsange is associated with NHM since 2009 and has been working as Block Program Manager (BPM) at the Phanda block, Bhopal. Currently, he is also having additional responsibilities of looking after the quarantine centre during COVID 19 pandemic.

Mr Gopendra has supervised the RISE module training and facilitated 41 ANMs and 21 MPW (Male Public Health Worker) to complete all modules of RISE training. He mentions that it's a very good and interesting learning tool and feels that completion of RISE modules has certainly improved the knowledge and skills of safe immunization practices among the learners. He added further that initially some of learners in higher age group were worried that how will they complete the course embedded with technology which they use minimally. However, he encouraged them saying that it is not an examination where good/poor ranking will affect but these modules would rather help boosting their confidence.

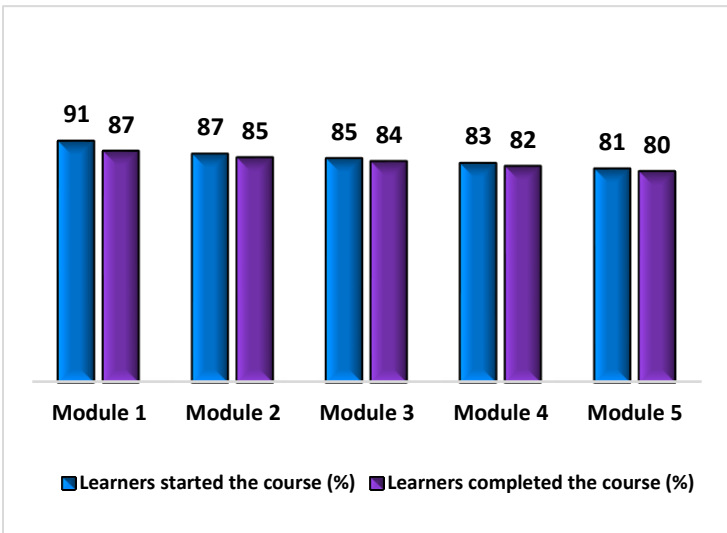
Mr Gopendra further appreciated the RISE app and mentioned that the best feature of the app is that **one can learn anytime and anywhere at her/his own comforts (after completing official and family responsibilities) and there is no time restriction to complete the course).**

After receiving his login id & password as a supervisor, he started monitoring the learners through the dashboard and closely followed up with the learners who had not started the training. He called them over phone and motivated them to start and complete the course and also resolved any problem they faced during the course. As revert responses, learners conveyed him that they have started enjoying the course and discussed/shared their status with peer groups. Now, they like the quizmaster as well and finishes as soon as it rolls out.

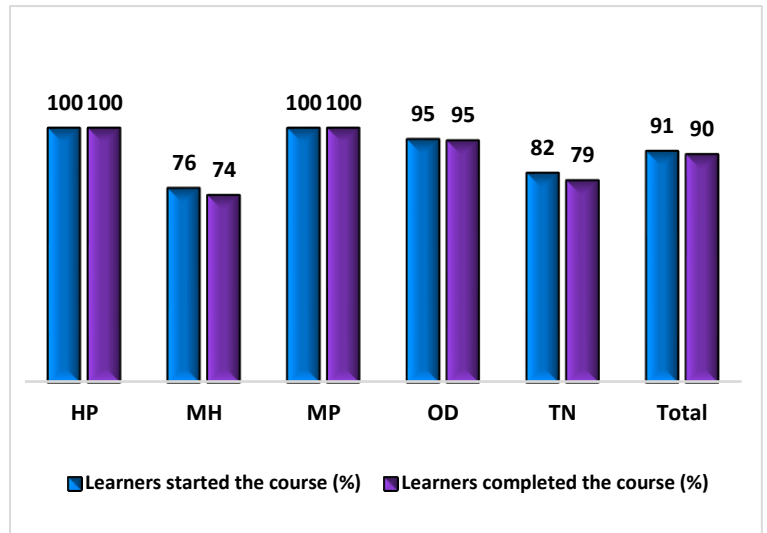
According to him, it is a very effective learning tool and therefore, he suggested adding new modules on concurrent health issues like COVID-19, DASTAK ABHIYAN etc. Lastly, he praises the app by saying **“RISE एक शानदार ऐप है। नॉलेज ऐप में सुरक्षित है और हमेशा उनके साथ है”** (RISE is a great App. Knowledge is saved in the app and it is with them 24 hrs)

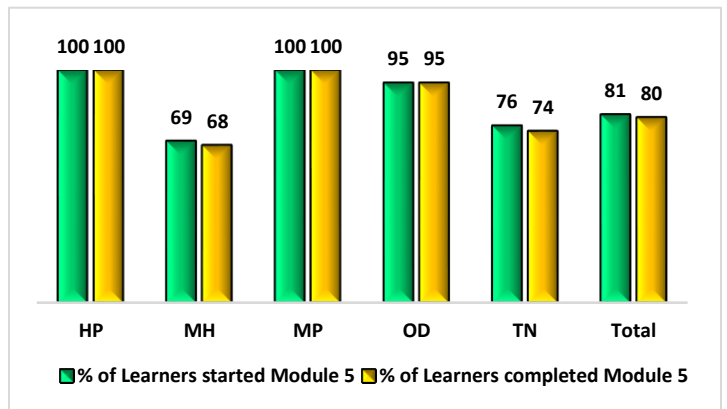
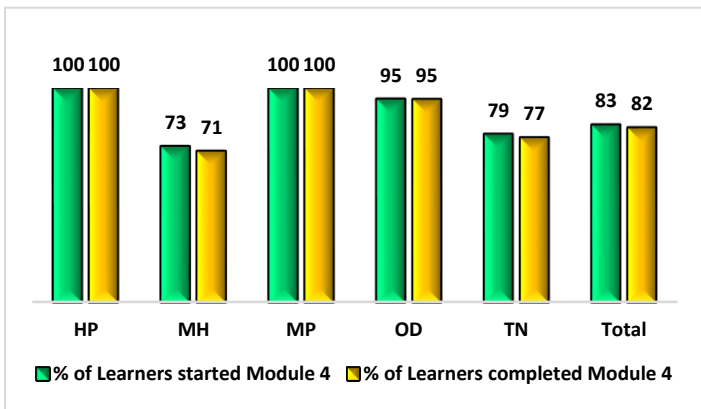
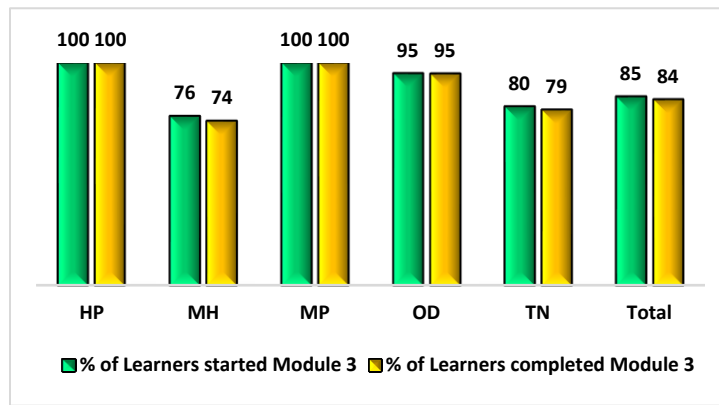
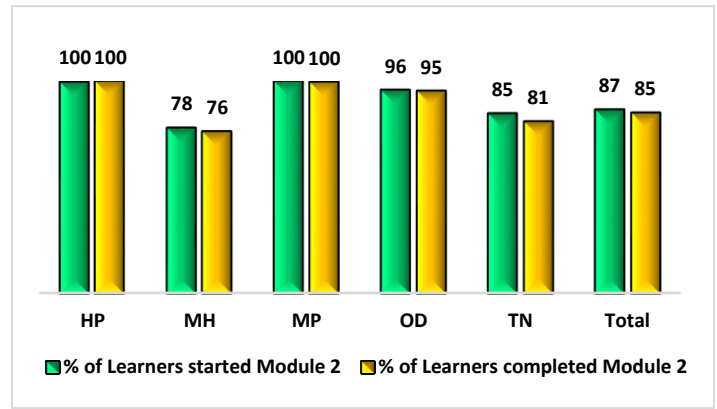
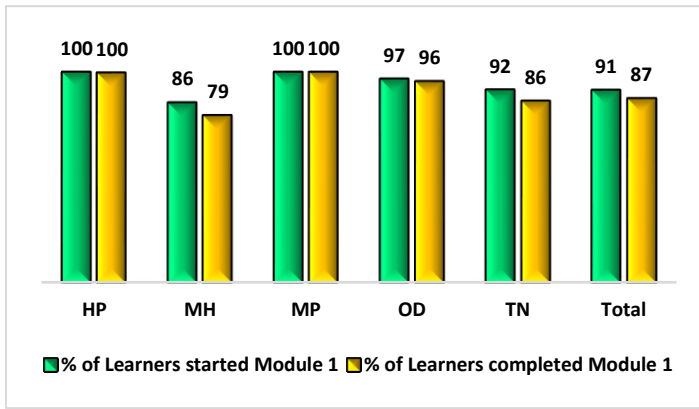
COVERAGE (average of 5 states)- Module-wise



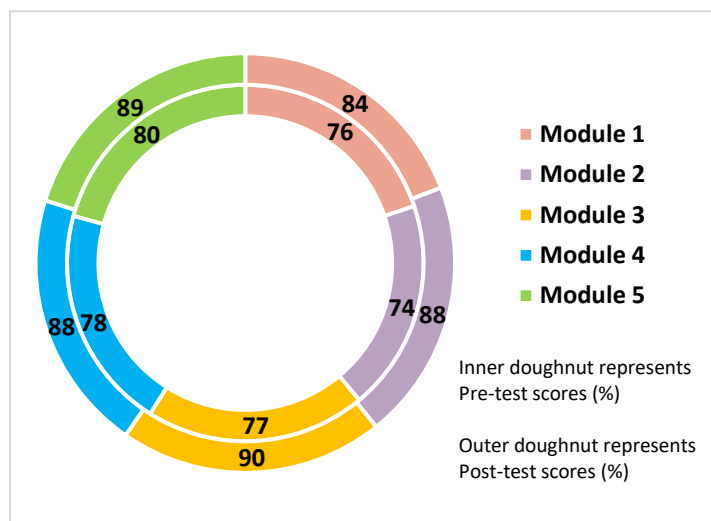
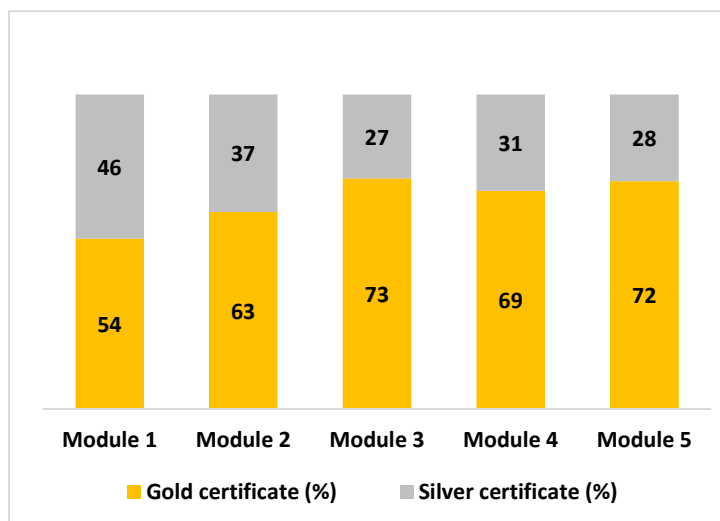
COVERAGE (average of 5 modules)- State-wise

Pune, Maharashtra
